



My Sight Word House

You Will Need

- House dice. Cut out from the template, glue on the green tabs and fold to make the dice.
- Sight Word House Boards - one for each player
- Adventures Word Cards for the words you are practicing. If you haven't already printed these, you can print them at www.sightwordadventures.com/adventures-cards

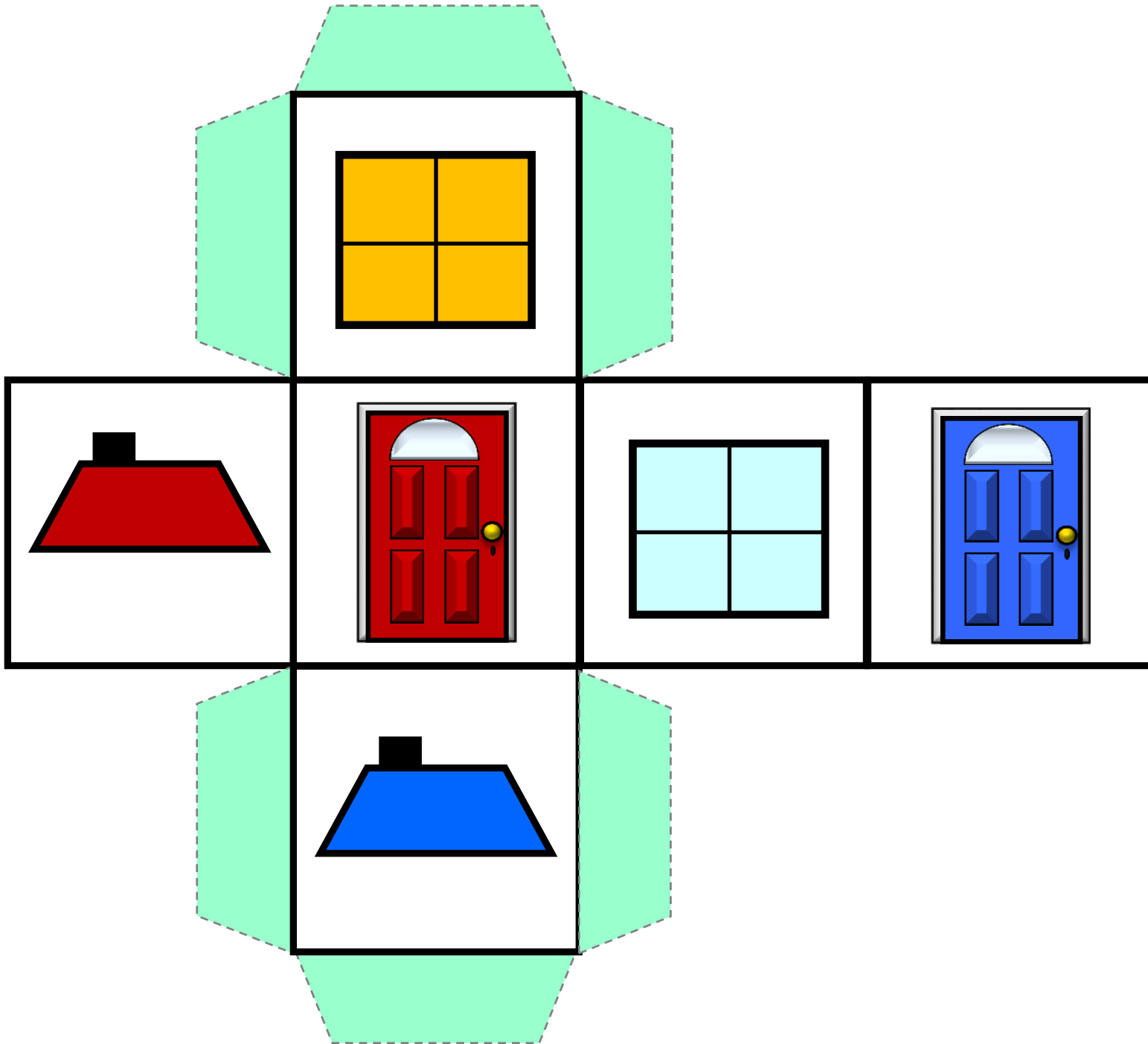
How To Play

The goal is to build your Sight Word House by placing a Word Card on each window, one on the door and two on the roof.

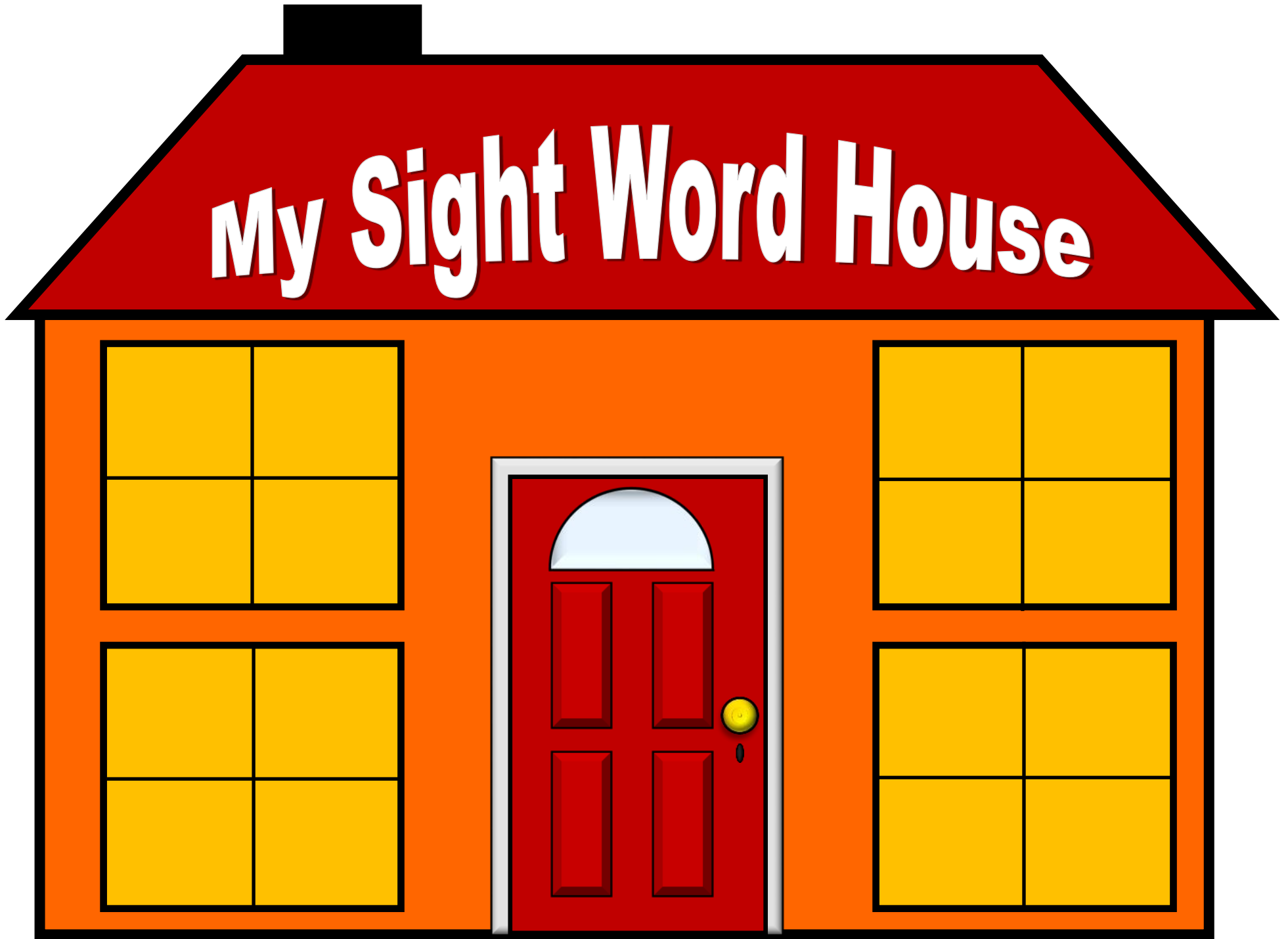
Place the Word Cards in a pile face down. The players throw the dice in turn.

- If the dice shows a window, door or roof that matches the thrower's House Board, then he gets to pick a Word Card from the pile. If he can read it, he wins it and he can place it on the door, window or roof of his House Board, as shown by the dice. If he *can't* read it, put it to the bottom of the pile and his turn ends. (Teacher can read the word to him before putting it to the bottom of the pile so he can recognize it next time).
- If the dice lands on a window, door, or roof that matches *another* player's House Board, then the thrower gets to steal a card from that player. For example if the dice lands on a window then the thrower can steal a card from the other player's window and place it on his own window. When he picks a card from the other player's board, if he can read it, he gets to keep it, but if he can't read it, he must give it back.

The first player to have a Word Card on each window, one on the front door and two on the roof is the winner.
